



SOMETHING BETTER

The book of Hebrews is a masterpiece of Christian apologetics. Each chapter uncovers a personal God who invites us into an intimate relationship with Him. In the pages of this unique New Testament book we encounter a loving Creator who has entered into the experience of the human race, emotionally, spiritually and physically.

GOD LONGS FOR A RELATIONSHIP WITH YOU

Hebrews is a relational book. A relationship can be defined as a specific connection between objects, entities or concepts. A typical form of relationship is the social one between people usually made through some form of introduction. Hebrews is written to initiate just such a relationship between us and our Creator God (Hebrews 1:2). Our encounter with God begins in Hebrews as God first reminds us of His ongoing pursuit as recorded by the prophets (Hebrews 1:1). He then initiates communication with us Himself, personally through the Son (Hebrews 1:3). God describes Himself as the divine, infinite Being visiting our world as a human being so we can personally know Him (Hebrews 2:14). God longs for a close, intimate, loving, interpersonal relationship with every person in the world.

GOD WANTS US TO EXPERIENCE SOMETHING BETTER

In 13 chapters, Hebrews makes use of the word "better" some 13 times, which is why "something better" is a major theme of this epistle, and the chosen theme for Light Bearers Ministry's 31st Annual Convocation.

Introduction

Hebrews 1 reveals a picture of a God who does not require sacrifice from us, but one who makes the sacrifice for us—a better God (Hebrews 1:3). This is a God who takes the nature of humanity upon Himself, assuming personal responsibility for our sins—a better man (Hebrews 2:9). God has built us a better home (family) free from guilt and condemnation—a better house (Hebrews 3:6). A home free from guilt leads us to a better rest—a salvation rest of grace through faith in Christ (Hebrews 4:10). Salvation rest in Christ provides us with a better obedience—in Christ our righteousness, the author of our salvation (Hebrews 5:9).

In Hebrews 6 we find *better promises*—God's promises to us based upon His enduring word (Hebrews 6:13-18). Our attention is then directed to *a better priest*—Jesus who ever lives to intercede for us (Hebrews 7:25). The next chapter naturally introduces *the better covenant*—based on God's promises to us, not our promises to Him (Hebrews 8:6). Then we are directed to *a better sanctuary*—in the heavens where Christ stands in the presence of God for us (Hebrews 9:11).

Hebrews 10 follows by pointing us to *a better sacrifice*—the sacrifice of God Himself, in the person of Christ (Hebrews 10:10). Hebrews 11 shows us how God sees us by faith with all of our failures covered by the blood of Christ, leading us to *a better experience* (Hebrews 11:40).

Hebrews 12 directs our focus to Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith—which leads to *a better victory* (Hebrews 12:1-2). And the final chapter completes the picture by pointing us to *a better kingdom*—led by a God who will never leave nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5).

The book of Hebrews is bursting with good news, which is exactly the point. This book and this Convocation are all about *Something Better*.

OUR PRAYER FOR CONVOCATION

As we behold the "something better" in the transforming message of Hebrews, may each of us experience close fellowship with God and one another, is our prayer for Light Bearers 31st Annual Convocation. Amen.

At Light Bearers we are not only excited about spreading the gospel overseas through printed literature, we are equally passionate about sharing the love of Christ in our local community. We work and live just a stone's throw away from the city of Eugene, Oregon. Eugene is a highly-secular, college town of over 150,000 people. Almost 30,000 of

those people work or study on the campus of the University of Oregon. This city is as ripe as any mission field on the globe and we have a heart for reaching it.

Once again, God blessed us with an outstanding group of students for our 2014 ARISE discipleship programs, both in the US and Australia. Of the 28 students in the US, we invited nine of them to stay for a year-long internship. The internship affords them continued instruction in theology, evangelism and, most of all, further ministry experience. Two major components of their outreach efforts are campus ministry at the University of Oregon and active

roles at a recently launched church plant in Eugene—Storyline Adventist Church.
